REGULATIONS

1. International Film Festival »Sport & Tourism« Kranj 1966 will be held at Kranj, Slovenia, Yugoslavia from 13th—16th October 1966. Principal aim of this Festival is to show films dealing with the close conection between sports and tourism from various points of wiew as well as to stress this connection in artistic, professional and educational way.

2. Organizing Committee has the right to show also those films, which do not correspond to these regulations, but their content suits with the subject of sports and tourism. Such films will be shown in the Information Section. Films will be selected by a Special Board appointed by the Organizing Committee.

3. Festival will be under the auspices of the Yugoslav Federation of Physical Culture Orga-

nizations and Yugoslav Federal Committee for Tourism.

4. The following films should enter the competition:

a) films with subject

b) documentary films

c) educational d) scientific

e) animated

Lenght of the films should not exceed 45 minutes.

Films having been produced from the year 1961 up to now will be admitted to the compe¹ition as well as those having been prized since 1961.

5. Organizing Committee will accept films produced on 35 mm and 16 mm filmtrack. Film copies will be shown in original version or synchronized in English or French or with sub-titles in these two languages.

6. Entry forms for the participation at the First Film Festival »Sport & Tourism« Kranj 1966 should be sent by September 10th 1966 to the address: Festival jugoslovenskog filma, Beograd, Knez Mihajlova 19/III, Yugoslavia. Please, enclose the following to the entry form:

a) 2 copies of the dialogue in one of these languages: English, French, Russian and

all information and publicity material on these films and some photographs.

7. Organizing Committee is going to take into account the films, that will be sent to this address: Festival jugoslovenskog filma, Beograd, Knez Mihajlova 19/III, up to September 10th 1966. In case that films do not arrive by September 10th 1966, the Organizing

Committee has the right to admit them only to the Information Section.

8. Each participant covers the transport costs of the films to Beograd (Yugoslavia), but the Organizing Committee covers the transport costs back to the country of origin. The

organizer will insure each copy of the films — its actual value-only for the period from their recept in Beograd and till the time of their dispatch to the country of origin.

9. Films admitted to the competition may be shown according to the programme of the Festival arranged by the Organizing Committee. Ten days before the commencement of the Festival the participants will be informed if their films have been admitted to the competition.

Films admitted to the competition will receive Special Participation Document. Special International Jury, appointed by the Organizer and consisting of the president and six other members will award prizes.

Jury regulations will be laid down by a Special Working Board, consisting of members of the Jury and the Organizer, and they are final and substantiated.

11. International Jury will award the following prizes:

First prize: »White Triglav«

Second prize: »Silver Triglav«
Third prize: »Bronze Triglav«

The Jury has the right to present special diplomas and gifts such as some fortnight stays at the most beautiful tourist places in Yugoslavia. Besides some other institutions and organizations will award prizes in cash.

12. Organizing Committee has the right to hand over the films entering the competition (not longer than 2 minutes) to the Yugoslav Television.
